

Year 4 PSHCE Overview

Autumn 1- Looking After Our Environment

This topic looks at the way that laws are made in our country. It looks at ways to save energy and develops and awareness of climate change.

Autumn 2- Risks

Here the children look at what a risk is and how to manage risks. It gives the children the chance to talk about drugs, smoking and alcohol and their dangers. It also looks at how to keep safe in their local area and what to do if they are bullied.

Spring 1- Money, Money, Money

In the spring the children look at what a bank does and different methods of paying for things. The children explore the basic costs of running a household and how to budget for different costs.

Spring 2- Chocolate

In this topic the children look at what countries chocolate comes from. They look at the process of making chocolate and who gets the money when we pay for it in the shops. They look at the idea of fair trade in relation to chocolate production.

Summer 1- Similarities and Difference

In the summer the children talk about the fact that we are all similar and different but that despite this we all need to get along. It talks about the connections between us and talks about ways of working co-operatively with each other.

Summer 2- Stereotypes

Here the idea of prejudice is explored and the children discuss the stereotypes in relation to jobs for males and females. They then go on to look at a range of jobs in our community, what sort of skills people need to do them and what sort of job they think that they might suit.
